

How to Print & Use Your “Questions to Chew On” Culture Discovery Cards

These cards are designed to spark real conversations when your child meets someone from another culture, whether at a festival, cultural fair, restaurant, market, or family gathering. Each question is kid-friendly and encourages listening, curiosity, and respect. Used together, they turn a simple encounter into a memorable cultural exchange your child will carry with them.

PRINTING:

- **Double-Sided Printing:** Set your printer to double-sided (flip on the short edge) so fronts and backs line up.
- **Cutting:** After printing, cut around the cards to separate them. As a bonus, feel free to laminate for extra durability.
- **Paper Choice:** Use cardstock or heavy paper for sturdy cards that last.

HOW TO PLAY:

When your child meets someone from another culture, let curiosity lead the way! Invite them to choose a card and ask the question out loud. If your child is too young to read, you can read the card for them and help spark their curiosity. These cards work best in settings where people are where people are happy to share their traditions, foods, languages, or stories — turning a simple hello into a memorable exchange.
